

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Application No. RBS-32A for renewal of uninterrupted water supply from the Raritan Basin System

The Hamilton Farm Golf Club, 1040 Pottersville Road, Gladstone, New Jersey 07934, has made application to the New Jersey Water Supply Authority, 1851 Route 31, Post Office Box 5196, Clinton, New Jersey 08809, for renewal of their uninterrupted water supply contract in an amount not to exceed 56 million gallons per year (MGY) or .153 million gallons per day (MGD), of which 50.4 MGY and .138 MGD is deemed consumptive. If approved, the contract would be for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2027.

The water would be withdrawn from 6 on-site wells, and 1 irrigation pond located on golf course property in the Township of Bedminster, Somerset County, New Jersey within the Raritan Basin System, and used for golf course irrigation purposes.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:11-3.2, that a public hearing will be held on said application on **FRIDAY, JULY 7, 2017** at 1:00 p.m., in the Conference Room, at the New Jersey Water Supply Authority Administration Building, 1851 Route 31, Clinton, New Jersey 08809, at which time all persons, corporations and civil divisions of the State may be heard for or against the granting of the application. This public hearing shall be held before a Hearing Officer of the New Jersey Water Supply Authority. The applicant and other interested parties may be represented by counsel, at their discretion.

Objections must be filed with the Authority in writing to either the address listed above or at info@njwsa.org on or prior to ON OR PRIOR TO JUNE 30, 2017, and each objection must particularly specify the grounds thereof. Such objections should be supported by sworn testimony at the hearing. A copy of any objection filed with the Authority should also be sent to the applicant. The application and any other pertinent data may be examined by any interested party at the Authority's Administration Building between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. weekdays.

The Hearing Officer may recommend approval or denial of the application to the Authority at a regularly scheduled Board meeting.
